Vide Order dated 7/3/2018 and 09/04/2018, directions were issued to all ULBs to incorporate the conditions regarding disposal of C&D waste/debris in the Construction License issued by the Local Authorities w.e.f. 01/04/2018 subsequent to the said directions of the Hon'ble High Court. The status of implementation of the directions by the ULBs to tackle the C&D debris menace is to be submitted to the Hon'ble Court.

In view of above, all ULBs are directed to give the following information:-

1. No. of applications received for grant of Construction Licences from 1/4/2018 onwards.
2. No. of Construction Licences issued by ULBs after 1/4/2018 till date.
3. No. of Constructions which has been granted Licences involve the demolition of old existing structures.
4. Method of disposal of the C&D debris in each case.

Further, all ULBs are hereby directed to take up the intensive cleaning drives exclusively for cleaning /clearing of all the sites/spots wherever C&D waste/debris has been lying. The C&D waste/debris should be cleared from all the sites/spots latest by 30/5/2018, and no further dumping shall be allowed thereafter. The cleared C&D waste/debris should be strictly deposited at the notified sites only.

The Commissioner, Corporation of the City of Panaji/Chief Officer of all the Municipal Councils are hereby directed to submit fortnightly report in this issue on the field situation after conducting a field visit.

This may be treated on TOP PRIORITY and compliance report be submitted to this office latest by 30/5/2018.
